## SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GAS SERVICE

### 19. Installation Standards

T

All gas installations must comply with the applicable provisions in the latest edition of the Standard for the Installation of Gas Appliances and Gas Piping, NFPA No. 54, Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Part 191-Transportation of Natural and Other Gas by Pipeline: Annual Reports and Incident Reports, Part 192-Transportation of Natural and Other Gas by Pipeline: Minimum Federal Safety Standards, Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Part 193-Liquefied Natural Gas Facilities: Federal Safety Standard 1988, as amended through September 1, 1989, Company Gas Standards and such laws and ordinances in force in the state, towns or communities in which the Company furnishes service.

#### Minimum Insulation Standards for Service to Residential Customers

1. The builder, developer, owner or other responsible party shall certify to Midwest Gas that new structures to be heated with gas shall be thermally insulated according to the standards contained in the Iowa Administrative Code Section 661-16.800(103A), cited as the "Iowa State Building Code Thermal and Lighting Efficiency Standards".
