Current Rates | Sample Monthly Gas Bill

Gas bills have two parts: supply and delivery. The supply portion of the bill represents the price paid by MidAmerican Energy to purchase gas supply for its customers, which is driven by market prices and is a dollar-for-dollar pass through to customers. MidAmerican does not mark up the natural gas fuel cost that is charged to you each month based on the amount of your usage. The requested rate increase will not impact this portion of your bill.

The delivery portion of a customer's bill includes the basic service charge, meter charge, delivery charge and any rate-specific administration fees. These are referred to as the "base rates." The requested rate increase applies to the base rate line items that are part of the delivery portion of your gas bill.


