BEAT THE FREEZE

SET IT TO SAVE. During the winter, keep your thermostat set to 68° during the day when you're home and awake, and 66° when you're away or asleep. This can help you save as much as 10% on your energy bills throughout the year.

GET SMART AND PROGRAM. Make saving automatic by using a programmable or smart thermostat that will adjust the temperature for you based on the time of day. Iowa and Illinois customers can qualify for a rebate up to \$75 on the purchase of a new smart thermostat!

SAVE ON SPACE. Is one room in your home always a bit chillier than the others? Rather than cranking the heat to warm up that room, use an electric space heater when using that space. Using a space heater









occasionally actually uses less energy than overheating your whole home. **BUNDLE UP.** We all want to be comfortable in our home, putting on socks or grabbing a blanket can usually provide the heat you're looking for. Instead of turning up the thermostat, make sure you're dressed for a Midwest winter first.

WINTERIZE. Even newer homes and apartments can let cold air in. Check for drafts around windows, doors and electrical outlets that might be letting in cold air. Install door sweeps, insulation, rubber stripping and caulk to fill in gaps that are making your space cold.
