WHEN TO APPLY

Heating assistance applications will be taken starting Oct. 1, 2023.

WHAT TO PROVIDE

- Verification of all income for the past 30 days or 2022 tax return if self-employed
- Social Security numbers for <u>all</u> household members – documentation required
- > Recent heat bill

WAGE EARNERS

Please bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application.

FIXED INCOME

This income may include: Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Aid to Families with Dependent Children (ADC), veteran's assistance, unemployment insurance and pensions. Please bring copies of your check stubs from the previous 30 days.

SELF-EMPLOYED/FARMERS

Please bring a copy of your most recent federal income tax return.

If you receive interest or dividend income, alimony or child support, it will also need to be verified.
