SIMMER DOWN YOUR HOT WATER USAGE

If your water is heated by natural gas, shorten your shower time and the amount of water used in baths, or install low-flow faucet aerators, low-flow shower heads and pipe insulation.

SEAL UP DRAFTS

Check windows, doors, fireplaces and electrical outlets for air leaks. Weatherizing your home will help reduce your natural gas usage and can make your home more comfortable.

CHECK YOUR HEATING SYSTEM

Have your heating system serviced to keep it running properly and efficiently. Change your furnace filters regularly.

USE SPACE HEATERS SAFELY

Small space heaters can help you keep rooms warm without using energy to heat your entire home. But, there can be safety risks – space heaters are the cause of 25,000 residential fires each year. Follow these safety guidelines when using space heaters to help you stay safe – and warm – in your home.

- Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from flammable items, such as papers or curtains.
- Avoid leaving a space heater unattended for long periods of time, especially around children and pets.
- Place space heaters on low, flat surfaces preferably on the floor.
- Always plug a space heater directly into the wall, not an extension cord or power strip. But, keep it away from the wall once plugged in to avoid overheating.
- Do not place space heaters in potentially wet areas, like bathrooms or kitchens.

Remember, space heaters ONLY cut down on energy bills if you turn down the thermostat for the whole house. They're best used when you're spending time in one room of your home for a short period of time.
