To continue providing safe, reliable service, we've asked the Iowa Utilities Commission to approve an update to our natural gas delivery rates.

On the back of this insert, you'll see an estimate of how this change could affect a typical monthly bill. For most customers, this reflects a modest increase in the cost of delivery service. You'll also see how our rates compare across Iowa. Even with this proposed change, MidAmerican would continue to be among the lowest-cost natural gas providers in the state.

This matters because we are focused on delivering reliable service without compromising long-term affordability.

The review process with the Commission is how rates are set in Iowa. We provide detailed information on our costs and the work being performed for maintenance and upgrades. The Commission reviews that information and determines the final approved rates.

We're always improving the system that serves you. That means replacing aging gas mains and distribution pipes, improving safety and maintaining reliable service, especially during peak winter demand. These long-term investments help keep the system operating the way you expect.

### GAS BILLS HAVE TWO PARTS

**Supply** is the cost of the natural gas MidAmerican buys for you. This price is set by the market and passed directly to customers with no markup. The requested rate increase does not affect this part of your bill.

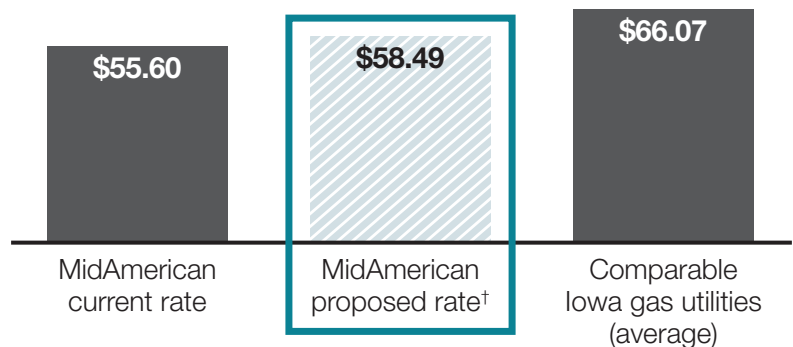
**Delivery** covers getting gas to your home and maintaining the system. This includes the basic service charge, meter charge, delivery charge and other fees. The requested rate increase applies only to this portion of your bill.

## How do our bills compare?

Even with this increase, MidAmerican's natural gas rates would be lower than other Iowa gas utilities (on average), as you can see from the chart at the right.
